APPROVAL OF MINUTES: October 1, 2018

Since the Subcommittee was ad hoc at that time there were no minutes from the meeting.

CURRENT BUSINESS

1. UPDATES ON SHORT TERM PROJECTS

a. Community garden

Since the City was unsuccessful at negotiating with a vendor for the reuse of the former Sun Valley Golf Course clubhouse, it was determined that this area could be used for a community garden. A community garden committee has been established. A fundraiser was held at The Hills on 5/29/19. The committee will be deciding on the best governance structure, likely with the La Mesa Park and Recreation Foundation until it can establish its own entity. The next meeting is on 6/10/19. Councilmember Alessio asked that the subcommittee be notified once a decision was made on governance structure.

b. Picnic area

Phase 1 entryway and picnic area construction began on 5/20/19. A new entry will be constructed behind the Kuhlken Field parking lot and include a gate, decomposed granite path, picnic tables and landscaping. Staff is working on submitting a grant for funding nets around Kuhlken Field.

c. Dog park

The area originally planned for a dog park at the North end of the park will not work because of the large topographic changes in this area. Canine Corners is not able to assist the City with another dog park at this time because it plans to expand its facilities at Harry Griffen Park.
