SUBJECT: Appointment of Applicants to the City Council's Citizens Task Force on Homelessness

On February 26, 2019, the City Council unanimously approved establishing a City Council's Citizens Task Force on Homelessness. City Council directed staff to recruit for the Task Force in the same manner as the City's Board's and Commission's recruitment process. Staff sent a news release with information on the newly formed Task Force to the media. In addition, a recruitment flyer was published on the City website and posted in City Hall.

The Task Force shall serve as an advisory body to the City Council on homelessness. Initial work will be educating members on current City practices regarding homelessness, some of the typical challenges the City faces, and what regional resources are available to the City. The Task Force will then create a plan to articulate the role of the City, other governmental agencies and non-profit organizations regarding homelessness and provide recommendations to the City Council. The Task Force will meet 1-2 times per month. Once the Task Force's task is complete the Task Force will be dissolved.

Interviews were conducted at the City Council meeting of April 23, 2019. The Council Homeless Subcommittee made up of Mayor Arapostathis and Vice Mayor Parent will make the appointments with the approval of the City Council at the May 14th City Council meeting.

Attached is a brief description of the requirements, the number of openings and the names of each applicant seeking to be appointed.

Staff recommends the Council Homeless Subcommittee make the appointments to fill the Task Force, with the approval of the City Council, and that the City Council adopt the attached resolution confirming the appointments.
