

# Old Post Office

## 8393-95 La Mesa Boulevard

---



The Old Post Office Building at the southwest corner of La Mesa Boulevard and 4th Street was constructed in 1939. It was designed by noted local architect Frank L. Hope, Sr. in the Art Moderne style and is the first commercial building to achieve local landmark status in La Mesa. The contractor, Weston Hicks, and property owner, George Sheldon,

were early civic leaders. The windows and corner entry are the most notable features; glass blocks surround the front door and the metal-framed windows are tall and narrow.
