SUBJECT: Interview of Applicants for Two Vacancies on the Mobility Commission

On November 24, 2020 the Council adopted Ordinance No. 2020-2883 increasing the Mobility Commission ("Commission") membership from 5 to 7 voting members. Staff recruited for the two vacancies in the same manner as the City's Board and Commission recruitment process. Staff published a recruitment flyer and application on the City website and social media outlets and posted the flyer at City Hall.

The two newly created seats are as follows:

- (1) One member shall preferably have significant experience with climate or environmental issues; and
- (2) One member shall preferable have experience as a vulnerable road user, who frequently walk, ride a bicycle, or use another vulnerable non-car mode of transportation.

Pursuant to La Mesa Municipal Code ("LMMC") Section 12.08.080, "Member's terms shall be maintained so that not more than four terms expire in any given year and appointments may be made for less than a four-year term in order to accomplish that purpose." To comply with LMMC Section 12.08.080, the term of the appointee with experience with climate or environmental issues shall expire on June 30, 2022, and the term of the appointee with experience as a vulnerable road user shall expire on June 30, 2023.

Attached are applications from citizens who wish to be considered for appointment to fill the vacancies on the Commission. The applicants have been invited to attend the meeting and make a brief three-minute presentation describing their qualifications and interest in serving on the Commission.

The applicants will be called forward for their interviews by the City Clerk. After the presentation you may ask questions of the applicant, if you wish.

The appointment will be made at the City Council meeting on February 23rd.
