**NOTICE  
OF APPEAL PROCEDURES**

Actions taken by the Development Advisory Board may be appealed to the Planning Commission. If you disagree with any action of the Board and wish to file an appeal, you must do so within ten days of this meeting. **In order to file an appeal, you must submit an appeal letter stating why you disagree with the Board's action to the Office of the City Clerk, City Hall, 8130 Allison Avenue along with a \$25.00 appeal fee. If no appeal is filed within this period, the action becomes final.**

Once the appeal is filed, the item will be scheduled for the next available Planning Commission meeting. If the item was previously noticed to the neighborhood, new notices of the Planning Commission will be mailed out ten days prior to the hearing date. The Commission will then hold a public hearing to consider the appeal.
