VACANCY: Youth Advisory Commission

NUMBER OF VACANCIES: Eight (8) - One appointee will fill the position vacated by Elyse Wainscott whose term expires September 30, 2024; Two appointees will fill the positions vacated by Fahim Chakibou and Anthony Martinez whose terms expire September 30, 2024, and held alternate positions; Two appointees will fill the positions vacated by Adriana Flores and Kennedy Haytasingh whose terms expire September 30, 2023; Two appointees will fill the positions vacated by Dylan White and Camille Forga whose terms expire September 30, 2023 and held alternate positions; and one appointee will fill the alternate position with term expiring September 30, 2023.

All applications must be submitted to the City Clerk's office, located in La Mesa City Hall, 8130 Allison Avenue, La Mesa, by the specified due date.

PURPOSE OF COMMISSION: The Commission serves as an advisory body to the City Council on matters pertaining to programs, projects and issues that address the concerns of youth in the community. It is the responsibility of the Commission to explore issues and develop activities that will promote positive youth relations in the City of La Mesa.

The Youth Advisory Commission is comprised of nine members and six alternates appointed by the Mayor, subject to confirmation by the City Council. Commissioners are appointed for two-year terms and serve without compensation. Alternates attend the Commission meetings and only vote in the event of the absence of a Commission Member.

The age of each member at the time of appointment or reappointment shall be not less than 13 years nor more than 20 years, 364 days. All members shall be residents of the City or attend school in the City. 'Attend school' shall mean either public or private school, general or special education program (K-12th grade), or college or university. It does not mean an independent special interest program (such as karate or ballet instruction).

Meetings are held on the second and fourth Monday of the month at 4:30 p.m. at the Community Center.
