Home Maintenance and Improvement

Paints, paint stains, varnishes
Pool chemicals
Glue and adhesives
Wood preservatives
Treated wood (no longer than 3 feet)

Electronic Waste*

Computers and computer components
TVs, VCRs, DVD players, radios
Small household appliances (not containing Freon)
Printers and scanners
Stereo equipment
Telephones and cellular phones

Universal Waste

Batteries (auto, household and rechargeable)*
Mercury items (thermostats, thermometers, etc.)
Electrical switches and relays
Neon bulbs
Fluorescent lights (tubes & compact bulbs)
Aerosol cans

Do Not Bring: Waste from businesses, medical waste or equipment, prescription drugs, tires, any items containing Freon or compressed gas (propane is okay), explosives, or ammunition.

There is a limit of 15 gallons or 125 pounds of waste (California law prohibits the transportation of more unless specially permitted).
